ORDINANCE 2014 - 1

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE 98-2

BE IT ORDAINED AND ADOPTED by the Town Council of Stinesville, Indiana as follows:

- 1. The highways, roads, and streets located within the Town's corporate limits which shall have a one-way directional designation are described in Appendix A, which is incorporated into this Ordinance and shall be considered a part of this Ordinance.
 - 2. Appropriate signs shall be erected for these one-way streets.
- 3. Every vehicle operator shall drive his vehicle in the direction designated by the one-way sign, except when directed otherwise by a police officer.
- 4. Any vehicle operator who is found to have violated any provision of this Ordinance commits an ordinance violation and shall be fined not less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) for each violation.
 - 5. Ordinance 98-2 is hereby repealed in its entirety.
- 6. This Ordinance takes effect upon its final publication according to the procedure specified by Indiana Code 5-3-1.

This Ordinance was passed and adopted by the Stinesville Town Council on the 6^{th} day of November, 2014.
