ORDINANCE 98- /

An ordinance establishing regulatory stop conditions for vehicular traffic on designated roads, streets, and highways at their intersections; at railroad at-grade crossings; at fire or other emergency vehicle access points; and at other locations as listed, all Devices for Streets and Highways.

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Town Board of Stinesville of Monroe County, Indiana, to promote safety and efficiency with regards to vehicular traffic in and around its jurisdiction of Monroe County, and;

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Stinesville has authority to erect signs, signals, barricades, and other traffic control devices as deemed necessary through traffic engineering studies, accident analysis, efficiency studies, experience, and other pertinent data in conformance with the Indiana Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF STINESVILLE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. All prior and existing ordinances dealing with the regulation of vehicular traffic in and around Stinesville and duly enacted by the Town Board is incorporated by reference into this ordinance and shall be considered a part of this ordinance as such.

SECTION 2. The following highways, roads, and streets shall have stop locations as described in Appendix A, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION 3. Appropriate signs shall be erected for these stop streets in reasonable conformance with the Indiana Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways and good traffic engineering practice.

SECTION 4. Any Vehicle operator who is found to violate any provision of this ordinance commits and ordinance violation and shall be fined not less than the Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than direction Dollars (\$100.00), in accordance with Fourth Stinesville Code Section
